DANIEL'S STORY



Daniel has lived at Lowe House since 2018 with two friends and his brother. "Living here in affordable housing has helped us tremendously. I live close to where I work as a church administrator. If I had to pay for a market rate apartment here in Pasadena it would be beyond my means. Living here has also helped my friends and my brother who have been through some difficult challenges in the past. They have been homeless or at risk of homelessness." They now have achieved a level of stability and we are able to encourage one another, share resources, and help each other grow in faith.
