### **NEW CASA DE ALEGRIA RENOVATIONS!**

The outdoor space at Casa de Alegria is getting a makeover! Though beautiful and a great place for children to run around, the grounds have been under utilized over the years. In an effort to make the space more usable and useful, we have acquired new playground equipment for the children at Casa and have put in new vinyl fencing to separate the play area from the parking area to keep the children safe. We are looking to add a bench or other seating for mothers to sit as they watch their children play. In addition, we will be putting in outdoor dining areas and a community garden. We are working with Arlington Garden in Pasadena to create a community garden with vegetables, fruits, herbs, and plants with an emphasis on plants that are native to the area. We are extremely grateful to Soroptimist International of Glendale who provided grant money to acquire materials and equipment to get this revitalization project started, as well as to the Lutheran Church in the Foothills for additional financial support.



# NEW FREE TAX SERVICES FOR LOW-INCOME HOUSEHOLDS

In April, we were thrilled to partner with Kaimore to host our very first Tax Day to offer free tax services to low-income households. Through this service held at Garfield Agape Court, we were able to assist our tenants and other low-income households in doing their taxes for the year, thanks to a wonderful team of volunteers from East West Bank. One of our residents spoke about her experience with the tax service, "I'm glad it was so close to home, and I don't have a lot of financial literacy so as I'm learning those things I can still have support. It was a good experience". The day was a great success, and we are thankful to be able to offer with Kaimore this vital service to our residents and community members.



### **EXTENDING A HELPING HAND THROUGH OUR GRANT EXPANSION**

Our Helping Hands Program is an on-going grant opportunity originally developed during the pandemic to help low income households who are facing financial difficulties pay their utility bills. Recently, we have expanded the grant to address a wider range of needs we identified in the community, including help with moving costs, utility set up, and car registration for families who are moving into permanent housing from homelessness or transitional housing programs. One grant recipient shares, "I am eternally and incredibly grateful that my boys have space with a roof, a table to eat food on, and a room where they can escape to when needed. However, with this new transition came added expenses from furniture to the most essential of needs, like utilities [and] the cost of transportation to and from school to attend classes on campus and resuming my student teaching hours."
