I am currently attending Cal State Dominguez Hills in pursuit of getting my bachelor's in Liberal Studies and getting my teaching credentials in Special Education. I am also a first-generation college student who is enthusiastic about the education of youth and the large population of homeless students in Los Angeles. After being homeless, living in our



car to transitioning into a homeless shelter [the last 2 years have been an emotional experience with a surge of overwhelming joy] I can finally say we have a home, our very first place. I am eternally grateful that programs like Beacon Housing exist for families in the greater Los Angeles area. I do not know what difficulties we might have been facing if they were not available. It has been an incredible adjustment to say the least and that I am eternally and incredibly grateful that my boys have space and a roof, a table to eat food on and a room where they can escape to when needed. "
