BEACON HOUSING ASSISTS FIRE-IMPACTED HOUSEHOLDS WITH OUR HELPING HAND GRANT

This year started unexpectedly for everyone with the fires that devastated so much of our community, and we continue to grief with our neighbor. In response to the Eaton fire here in our service areas of Northwest Pasadena/Altadena, we opened up our Helping Hand grant to those who were impacted by the fires. We have been so heartened by the overwhelming amount of support to help us get critically-needed financial assistance quickly to those in need, including from La Canada Presbyterian Church, United Way of Greater Los Angeles, the Pasadena Community Foundation, Bob's Furniture and an anonymous donor who not only seeded the grant but also offered a \$25,000 match. Because of the generosity of these organizations, we will be able to provide cash grants to 100 families who have suffered such losses not only to their homes, but also to their livelihood. As a helping hand recipient shared with us: "We thank you so much for your generosity and commitment in impacting lives in need. My wife and I appreciate your grant dearly as we move forward in the recovery/rebuilding process. May God bless you and your organization."
