

Beacon Housing and Shepherd's Door Announce New Collaboration to Provide Urgent Housing for Domestic Violence Survivors

[Pasadena, 2 June 2025] Beacon Housing and Shepherd's Door Domestic Violence Resource Center are delighted to announce a new collaboration to provide urgent shelter and housing for those fleeing domestic violence. Through a master lease agreement, Shepherd's Door will utilize one of Beacon Housing's units to provide congregate-style emergency housing to their clients, helping to provide interim housing stability for up to three households while they receive case management and wraparound support services.

This collaboration furthers Beacon Housing's objective to leverage its expertise to assist partner organizations to meet their real estate/housing needs, while also helping to expand Shepherd's Door capacity to stabilize those facing homelessness due to domestic violence at a lower cost than long-term motel stays. "Domestic violence is one of the main drivers of homelessness for women. We are thankful for this opportunity to work together to support those facing the trauma of violence on their journey to long-term housing security and financial independence," said Tunisia Offray, Managing Director of Shepherd's Door, and Palin Ngaotheppitak, Executive Director of Beacon Housing, in a joint statement.
