



Applicant Conditions and Guidelines

To ensure a fair and thorough review process, all applications must meet the following conditions and guidelines. For any questions, assistance, or clarification please feel free to reach out to us at hello@beaconhousing.org.

1. Applicants must be certified low-income to receive a Helping Hand Grant
2. Applicants must have been affected by the Eaton fire (loss of home, displaced, loss of belongings, loss of employment, etc.)
3. Incomplete or inaccurate forms will not be considered - be sure to review all information carefully before submitting
4. Required documentation must be submitted through the “New Applicants” upload link
 - a. If documentation cannot be accessed, please reach out to [hello@beaconhousing](mailto:hello@beaconhousing.org) for alternatives
 - b. If documents submitted do not meet guidelines, finalists will be notified via email and may be required to provide additional documentation
5. Applicants can only receive 1 grant per calendar year per household
6. Grant funding is up to \$500 maximum per household
7. Grant funds will be distributed through check only
8. We ask applicants to follow-up requests in a timely manner
